### 1. ENTRIES

1.1. All Drivers must complete and sign the AASA Driver Indemnity form

### 2. INSURANCE

### 3. DRIVER APPAREL

3.1 Drivers are required to wear clothing of cotton or similar to cover them from neck to wrist to ankle, fully enclosed shoes of leather or similar and a helmet that complies with (at minimum) AS1698.

#### **4 VEHICLE AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

4.1 Vehicles must be event ready with all loose items removed from the vehicle.

4.2 All vehicles must undergo a safety check prior to undertaking any track activity.

4.3 Driving apparel including helmets must be presented at the safety check.

4.4 Vehicles which suffer damage must be re-examined before entering the track again.

#### **5 TIMING**

5.1 Please note that there is no timing allowed at this event

#### **6 PASSENGERS**

6.1 Please note that passengers must be attired to the same standard as drivers, and must have completed and signed the passenger indemnity form.

#### **7 EVENT FORMAT**

7.1 In Commences Engine Star at 10.am Non Racing Demonstration Events Start At 10.30 through to 12 noon 1 hour break for Lunch , Then events continue from 1.00pm thru to 4.00pm

#### **8 FACILITIES**

8.1 Café Opens at 8.30 Am through to 3.30 Pm, Male & Female Toilets Public Address System

#### **9 NOISE**

9.1 The maximum noise limit is 94 db @ 30 metres measured at 30 metres.

9.2 Noise testing may take place at any time at the discretion of the Scrutineer or the Clerk of Course. Any car found to exceed the maximum noise emission limit will be suspended from the event until the Chief Scrutineer / Clerk of Course is satisfied that action has been taken to bring it within the limit. Any vehicle that exceeds the limit on two runs will be excluded from the remainder of the event.

#### **10 SMOKING**

10.1 Smoking in the pit areas is prohibited. [Click or tap here to enter text.](#)

#### **11 DRUGS & ALCOHOL**

11.1 Consumption of alcoholic liquor by drivers or crew is forbidden prior to the completion of the event in accordance with Schedule 3 of the NCRs. Any participant deemed by the Clerk of Course to be under the influence may be excluded from any on track activities and may be removed from the venue.

#### **12 FUEL**

12.1 No fuel available at the circuit Fuel can only be stored in 20 litre fuel drums or containers that meet AS1940/AS/NZS2906 or higher in order to comply with relevant State regulations. There is a maximum of 2 x 20 litre containers per bay at any one time.

12.2 Refueling must take place outside of garages/carports. All drivers, crew, and passengers must be outside of the vehicles while refueling. A crew member should be on stand-by holding a fire extinguisher during the refueling process for a hot vehicle.

#### **• Addendum for APPARELL**

Please bring your completed pre-scrutiny form if applicable. APPARELL Suit In the present context, the term "suit" refers to the items of external apparel that cover the torso and limbs of the occupant. Embroidery in Level H2 to H4 suits must only be in the outer layer and utilise flame resistant thread. Badges must be of flame resistant material and be sewn into the outer layer Level H1 Non-flammable# apparel that covers the person from mid-neck to wrist to ankles. Footwear Level B1 Fully enclosed footwear with non-synthetic upper and low heels. Footwear shall not extend above the general ankle area (i.e. no long boots). Boots for drivers should be close fitting. Level T1 A FUL FACE helmet to one or more of the following standards: • Australian or NZ standard AS/NZS1698 • European ECE 022 with 04 or 05 amendments • Snell SA2000 (Expires 12/2018) • Any Level T2 or T3 helmet
